

Vandals strike

Work on the new Borden Bridge was halted Monday after holes were drilled in the tires of earthmoving equipment. Peter Nemanishen of Nemanishen Contracting said crews initially believed the tires had been shot, but "a guy stayed here at camp" and didn't hear shots when the damage was done Saturday night. Further investigation revealed what appeared to

be drill holes through the 20- to 50-millimetre-thick tire walls. Tires, worth \$900 to \$4,000 each, on most of the 18 machines were damaged. The punctures on one vehicle were plugged and, if the system proved effective, he expected the 24-man crew would be back to work today. (S-P Photo by Peter Wilson)
